The **Paul G. Duke Academy for Community Leadership 2.0** has been created and designed specifically for experienced executive directors of nonprofit organizations **and** alumni of the Academy. This challenging and intensive Academy is coordinated by the Academy development team and participants. Participants help to develop the foundational agenda for each of the four monthly sessions that will explore nonprofit organizations—based on their backgrounds, experiences, pressing issues and needs—through self-analysis, organizational analysis, guest speakers, best practices and in-depth discussions. The final, or fifth session of the **2.0 Academy** will immerse attendees into the annual **Mosaic of Community Leadership Conference**—both as participants and as presenters. The new **Academy 2.0** is the latest collaboration between the Paul G. Duke Foundation and the Edison State Community College Center for Leadership Development—who have been working together for over 18 years to strengthen communities in the upper Miami Valley region—through leadership development.
