Futurist Chet W. Sisk says a bigger, more profound message about the current changes reshaping our world is getting missed. “We’ve lost the plot about why change creates opportunity and possibilities. My job is to get us back on point.”

Sisk, the founder of Universal Basic Resources, a change management company, and Co-Lead International, a non-profit think tank on change leadership, says the fear-based push of pop culture and algorithms around AI, climate change, cultural shift, and other trends has distorted the immediate future and made us give up our agency. “Funny how some of us thought *The Jetsons* cartoon series was a cool representation of life in the future. Now that we’re here, we’re frightened by it.”

Sisk believes the potential for AI to actually effectively address some of our most stubborn human challenges, particularly climate change, is an opportunity we don’t want to miss. “Everything around us is screaming for us to grow up and learn how to drive this new car. Only then will the drive become easier, the road will get smoother, and we’ll know how to read the GPS for the road ahead.”

A world traveler, former CEO of a local advertising agency, and author of 6 books, Chet has presented at The United Nations, Blue Cross Blue Shield, Alpha Graphics, The University of Kwazulu-Natal in Durban, South Africa, The National Council of State Legislators, and hundreds of other organizations on change and transformation. Chet currently serves The Colorado State Legislature as one of the top advisors and writers of a new state bill to determine how Colorado will manage the artificial intelligence wave. He is also a formal consultant with NVIDIA and part of the NVIDIA Partner Network.

Chet believes there are eight steps every organization and their people must take in 2025 to meet this moment of an emerging new world.
